What is The Resident Hub?

- Powerful online tool that ophthalmology residency programs use to facilitate, measure and track ophthalmic resident education
- Resource stocked with best-in-class courses, assessment tools, resources and reports
- Simple to use right "out of the box"
- Advanced features which more ambitious program staff can use to add value for their programs





What is The Resident Hub?

- Most importantly, The Resident Hub IS NOT the Resident Education Center.
- The Resident Hub is completely new. And it's completely different.



What did we learn from the Resident Education Center?

- All programs are different
 - size
 - locations
 - staffing levels
 - faculty commitment
- Program Directors have a really hard job and face a lot of challenges





The Resident Hub will make your job easier by addressing some of the challenges you face every day.





Program Director Challenge 1:

Not enough time to develop courses for my residents

- Prebuilt library of best-in-class standardized courses
- Courses cover all subspecialty areas
- Residents can use these on day one without any effort from program director. You don't have to do anything at all.





Program Director Challenge 2:

No faculty available to teach some important topics

The Resident Hub Solution:

Prebuilt library also includes courses in areas like Optics,
Pathology and Practice Management





Program Director Challenge 3:

No time (or interest) for learning how to use a new system

- If you don't have any time, you don't have to do a single thing.
- Residents can access the entire prebuilt course library on their own.





Program Director Challenge 4:

It's hard to benchmark my resident's level of knowledge, organize their test results and archive the data for retrieval later

- Stocked with thousands of multiple choice questions that you can easily group into assessments, pre-tests and post-tests
- All results are stored in the system
- System comes with easy to use reports for individuals and groups





Program Director Challenge 5:

It's time consuming to give assignments to residents and I don't know if residents have done their homework or not

- Email alerts remind residents when assignments are due
- Reports show resident progress and completed assignments





Program Director Challenge 6:

Residents expect more than classroom lectures and expect online learning to be available when and where they want it

- Provides a rich, robust multimedia learning experience that residents can access any time from any where

 - No time at all: residents perform independent study using the course library
 - Minimal time: you can access reports and develop your own courses, development plans and assessments





Program Director Challenge 8:

I just read something interesting on the ONE® Network and wish I could share it with my residents, but it's a pain to email everyone the link

The Resident Hub Solution:

 You can add content from the ONE Network to your resident's catalog with the click of a button using the fully integrated Quick-Pick tool

Note: residents must be AAO members, or members of ONE Network subscribing societies (international only) to access members-only content on the ONE Network, even when that content is added via the Quick-Pick tool.





Program Director Challenge 9:

My residents keep going to Google for help, and all they find is a confusing mess

The Resident Hub Solution:

 The course library ensures that your residents are getting correct, vetted information and not getting lost in unreliable search engine results



Sounds great, but I won't have any time to spend on this until next month ...or until after January 1

...or until after I hire the new program coordinator

- Your residents can start independent study in the course library right away without you doing anything
- When you have time to build and assign Development/Learning Plans to residents, The Resident Hub will
 - Recognize those Residents who already completed courses on their own
 - Give credits for courses that were completed prior to the launch of a Development/Learning Plan
