## **Severity Scale**


MILD = microaneurysms only

MODERATE = more than just microaneurysms but less that severe NPDR

SEVERE = Any of the following (4-2-1 rule) and no signs of proliferative retinopathy:

- Severe intraretinal hemorrhages and microaneurysms in each of four quadrants
- Definite venous beading in two or more quadrants
- Moderate IRMA in one or more quadrants

PDR = one or both of the following: neovascularization or vitreous/ pre-retinal hemorrhage





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
