OKAP[®] Special Accommodation Request

Program Directors must verify the need for accommodation of their resident(s) to the Academy for the following situations:

Special Accommodation for Religious Observance:

If any resident or fellow has a religious conviction that prevents them from testing on a Saturday, the Program Director can request special accommodations due to religious observance. **The Academy will not charge a fee for accommodation of religious observance.**

Special Accommodation for Disability:

If any resident or fellow has a disability, reasonable accommodations will be made in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as amended, or similar international standards. Requests due to disability should specify the nature of the disability and the accommodation being requested. To provide needed accommodation resources, a \$35 fee will be charged to your program for accommodation due to disability. There is an additional \$200 fee for a separate room accommodation.

Once a special accommodation request has been processed, the Academy will notify the resident and program of how to proceed with registration.
