

Author Checklist for Pearls Article

Before submitting your article, please review this checklist.

$\hfill \Box$ Contact info of corresponding physician (including back-up email and phone if the corresponding author is out of contact)
☐ Biographical information about the authors (e.g., Dr. Wwwww is an ophthalmology resident, and Dr. Xxxxxx is professor of ophthalmology; both are at the Yyyyy Eye Institute in City, State.)
☐ Financial disclosure (e.g., Dr. Wwww consults for CompanyX and lectures for CompanyY.)
\Box If you are a student, resident, or fellow, the manuscript must include a faculty member as a co-author to critically review and edit the manuscript for content accuracy and clarity of writing.
NOTE: Subspecialty articles must include at least one senior author in that subspecialty.
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\square Resolution. Digital images must be at least 300 dpi at 4 inches inches. (EyeNet can check resolution if you are unsure.) in JPG, TIF, EPS and BMP formats.
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☐ Citations need to be numbered in order in the text.
☐ Limit footnotes to fewer than 10, using these guidelines:
 Do not use a reference when stating information that is well established or is readily available through textbooks.
Use references when you:
o present specific data or research findings.
 discuss material that is speculative, new, or controversial—that is, not yet part of the mainstream.
Use one reference, rather than several, to support a statement
