

Review of Systems (ROS)

ROS can be problem pertinent (only the system in the HPI is reviewed), extended (2-9 systems), or complete (10-14 systems).

ROS Category	Examples of issues you might ask about
Eyes	Burning or itching; excessive tearing Discharge Redness Sudden loss or change in vision Swelling of lid or growth Other
Constitutional	Fever Weight loss
Ears, nose, mouth, and throat	Deafness Dry mouth Sinus infection Other
Cardiovascular	Chest pain/angina Congestive heart failure Heart attack High blood pressure High cholesterol Irregular heartbeat Low blood pressure Pacemaker/defibrillator
Respiratory	Asthma Bronchitis Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease Emphysema Tuberculosis
Gastrointestinal	Hepatitis/jaundice
Genitourinary	Bladder or kidney problems
Integumentary	Dermatitis
Neurological	Multiple sclerosis Stroke
Musculoskeletal	Arthritis
Hematologic/lymphatic	Infection Prostate
Allergic/immunologic	Allergies, hay fever
Psychiatric	Mental and/or emotional factors
Endocrine	Diabetes Thyroid
