Active engagement with IRIS Registry enables ophthalmologists to satisfy Measure Option 3, Specialized Registry Reporting, for Meaningful Use Objective 10, Public Health Reporting.

Because IRIS Registry is the only eye care specialized registry, it is the only specialized registry that the American Academy of Ophthalmology recommends to its members.

All ophthalmologist members of the Academy have access to the registry as a free member benefit.
