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INTRODUCTION

BuckheadFMV is pleased to present the results of the *BuckheadFMV Physician Call Coverage Burden and Compensation Survey 2019* published June 7, 2019.

SURVEY BACKGROUND

In order to collect the most useful data related to physician unrestricted call coverage burden and compensation, we surveyed physicians directly through two primary channels 1) state and specialty specific medical associations, and 2) direct email. Over the course of three months ending May 2019, we received responses from over 1,600 physicians across a wide range of specialties, geographies, demographic settings, and employers. As a result of our direct-to-physician approach, we collected unrestricted on-call burden and compensation information, including unique burden data unavailable from other survey resources:

- Days on call per month
- Required in-person response time
- Average phone call volume per 24-hour shift
- Average in-person visits per 24-hour shift

For purposes of our report of the survey, we split responses between compensated and uncompensated physicians, meaning physicians who receive a stipend specifically for providing call coverage services and those who do not.
