


ICD-10-CM PHYSICIAN TREE



Scribe | Physician Tip: **THINK** —
TYPE | RETINOPATHY | SEVERITY | EDEMA

Severity Scale

MILD = microaneurysms only



MODERATE = more than just microaneurysms but less than severe NPDR

SEVERE = Any of the following (4-2-1 rule) and no signs of proliferative retinopathy:

- Severe intraretinal hemorrhages and microaneurysms in each of four quadrants
- Definite venous beading in two or more quadrants
- Moderate IRMA in one or more quadrants

PDR = one or both of the following: neovascularization or vitreous/pre-retinal hemorrhage

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
